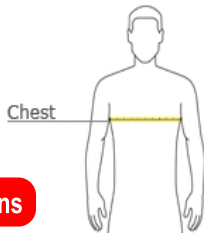

CHEST ACROSS: Measured one inch below

CHEST AROUND: With arms down at sides, measure around the upper body, under arms and around the fullest part of the bust.

BODY LENGTH: Measured from high point of shoulder to hem

SLEEVE LENGTH: Place hand on hip. Start at the center of the back of the neck and measure across the shoulder, to the elbow, and then down to the wrist.

Important tips on how to care for your new 100% Cotton Pique Polo Shirt

Our 100% Cotton Pique Polo shirts will never go out of style. Whether paired with skinny jeans or dressed up with a pencil skirt and blazer, colorful cotton shirts are endlessly chic. While cotton shirts are a wardrobe staple, keeping these tops from shrinking is a long-standing laundry problem. A new cotton shirt made from 100 percent cotton fibers will shrink minimally after the first washing if you avoid direct heat from a dryer. You'll need a precise method to keep your tops clean and shrink-free.

NORMAL WASHING: Use cold water setting on your washing machine set to the gentle cycle. Place the cotton shirts with similar-colored clothes in the washer to prevent discoloration. Rinse the clothes by using a cool or cold washing cycle. Use minimal agitation in the washing cycle to prevent shrinkage.

AIR DRY TO PREVENT SHRINKAGE: Remove the cotton shirts from the washing machine. Shake out wrinkles gently. Hang the cotton shirts on a padded wooden hanger to drip dry. Or, lay the shirts flat on a large towel in a well-ventilated area to air dry. Use padded wooden hangers instead of wire hangers to maintain the shape of the shirt when air drying.

IF YOU USE A DRYER: While we recommend air drying, if you choose to machine dry please do so on your dryers lowest heat setting. Please note that drying this garment in a dryer will cause it to shrink up the 15%. The more heat used in the washing and drying of this garment the more it will shrink.
